2 Inconclusive

Detectable deviation(s) (size, font, shape, location, etc.) unknown among OEM stamp variations, yet unclear to inspector team whether OEM or not. Authenticity cannot be conclusively determined from known data.

3 Owner Declared Non-OEM

Owner already declared Non-OEM stamps. No further evaluation by Judges needed. Remains eligible for Gold whether nearly perfect replicas, generic, or totally missing.

Non-OEM Deviation detected within stamps declared OEM or Unknown by owner (ghosts, rust, damage, deterioration, anomalies OK)
